anticipating the event.

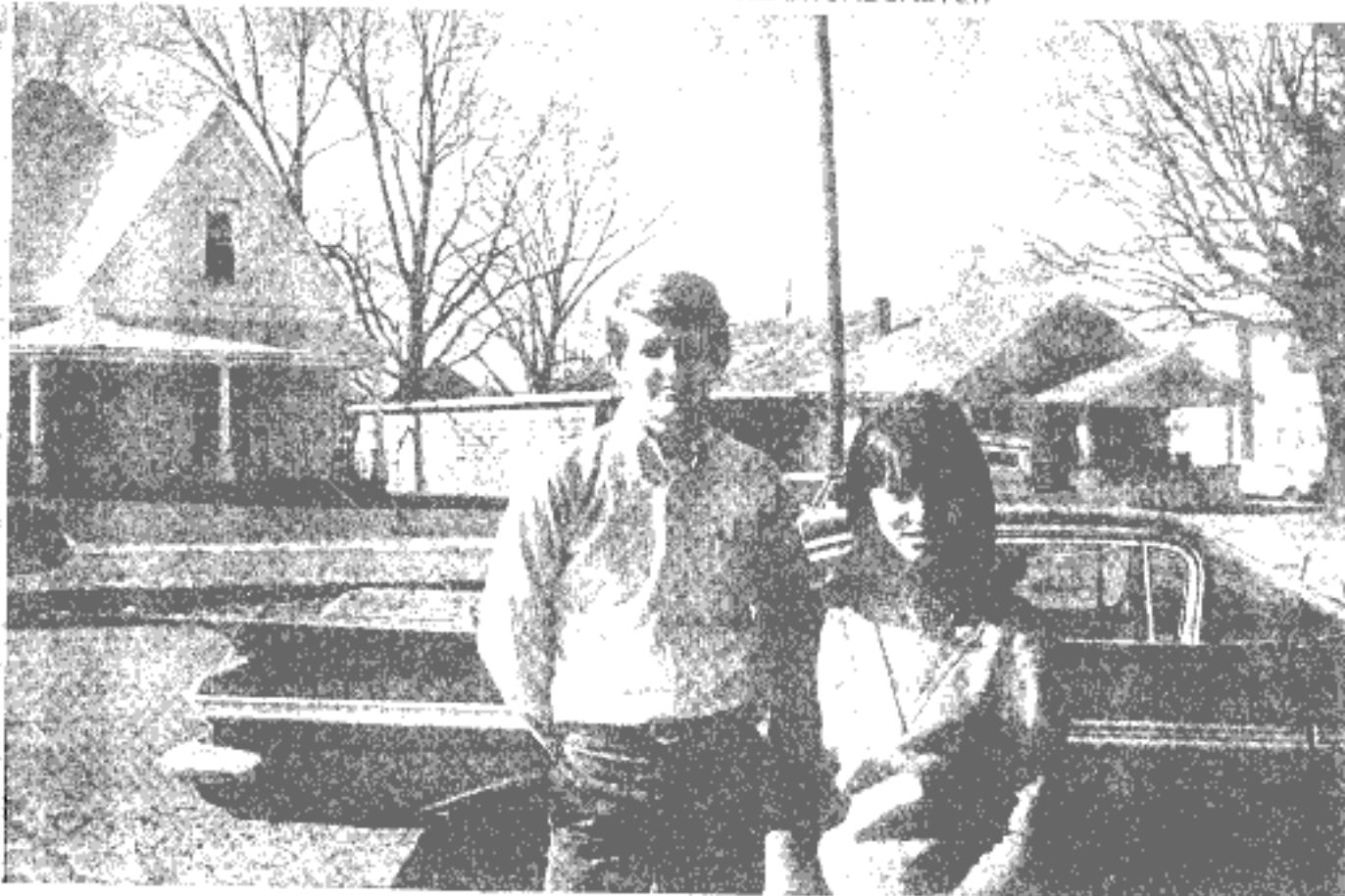
Also, they are expecting to be sporting soon their new club pins which they already have on order.

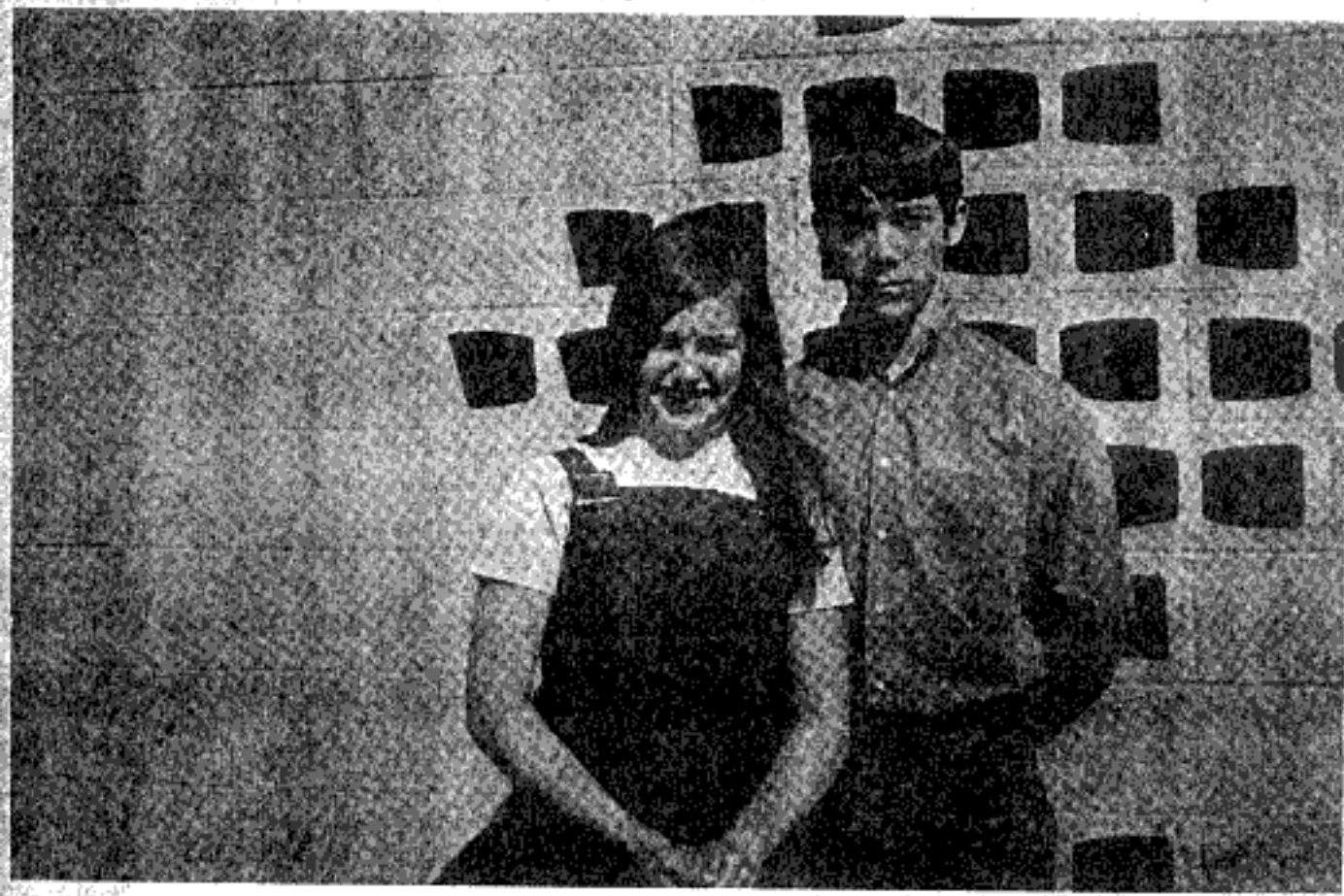
