or even Indian for that matter. They were simply listed in the record. For example, L. R. Anglin is listed in the 1909 index, but to my knowledge is not Indian. He purchased an interest in a full -blood Indian's estate. Hence he is listed in the index. I hope this alleviates any confusion.

Below is a proposal for an update of the society bylaws. These new bylaws, if approved will go into effect with the new calendar year. The bylaws proposal will be submitted for votes at the December 2006 meeting. Please attend the meeting to ensure your vote. (Only current members may vote).

## Proposed Constitution and Bylaw Changes

March 2006<br>CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS<br>of the<br>CHOCTAW COUNTY GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY<br>ARTICLE I<br>NAME

This not-for-profit organization shall be known and incorporated as the CHOCTAW COUNTY GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY.

ARTICLE II
PURPOSE
```

Section 1 - To aid in the preservation of genealogical and historical records.

Section 2 - To promote historical and genealogical research and the study of such research.

Section 3 - To promote interest and to educate and encourage people who are interested in genealogy and historical research.

Section 4 - To cooperate to the extent practical with other societies that are interested in genealogy and history and its preservation.

Section 5 - To collect, preserve, and publish historical and genealogical data relating to Oklahoma and Indian Territory, particularly, but not limited to Choctaw County.

Section 6 - To acquire a secure and permanent facility for records, books, microfilm, and other materials and the necessary equipment to study, collect, research and produce related fundraising projects.

ARTICLE III
MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 - Membership in the society shall be open to all persons who are interested in its purposes.

Section 2 - Annual membership dues shall be twenty dollars (\$20.00) per person. This amount may be adjusted annually by vote of the membership.

Section 3 - Membership dues shall be due January 1st, and may be prorated by quarter. If membership dues are prorated, the following schedule will apply:

Members joining in January - March shall pay $\$ 20$. Members joining in April - June shall pay $\$ 15$ for the remainder of the calendar year. Members joining in July - September shall pay $\$ 10$ for the remainder of the calendar year and those joining October - December shall pay $\$ 5$ for the remainder of the calendar year. All memberships will then be due January 1st. These amounts may be adjusted annually by vote of the membership.

> ARTICLE IV
> OFFICERS

Section 1 - All officers shall be members of the society.

Section 2 - The governing body of the society shall be the president, vice-president, secretary/treasurer and editor. The powers, rights and privileges of the society shall be exercised by the officers, subject to review by the society at general and special membership meetings.

Section 3 - The president, vice-president, secretary/treasurer and editor shall serve for a term of 1 year. Each officer eligible may be re-elected.

Section 4 - Vacancies shall be filled by nominations from the floor at the next membership meeting following the vacancy.

Section 5 - Officers may be removed from office by a $3 / 4$ affirmative vote of the governing body at any general meeting provided notification of the removal vote is made to the membership at least 1 week prior to the meeting.

## ARTICLE V <br> COMMITTEES

Section 1 - The president shall appoint such committees as may be deemed appropriate and necessary to the purpose of the society. Such committees shall expire with the term of the president.

Section 1 - General meetings of the society shall be monthly at a time and place to be announced by the president.

Section 2 - Officers shall be elected at the December meeting and shall take office at the January meeting. Nominations shall be taken from the floor.

Section 3 - Special meetings of the society may be called by the president as deemed necessary provided a 1 week notice is given in writing to the membership. Electronic notification (email) shall constitute fulfillment of the written notification.

> ARTICLE VII
> VOTING AND QUORUM

Section 1 - Members shall be eligible to vote after paying their dues.

Section 2 - A quorum shall consist of those members present at any general or special meeting providing that at least 2 officers are present in addition to the membership.

Section 3 - No proxy voting will be allowed.

## ARTICLE VIII <br> AMENDMENTS

Section 1 - This Constitution and Bylaws may be amended by an affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the society members in attendance at any general or special membership meeting.

Section 2 - Any proposed changes or amendments must be submitted to the membership in writing not less than 30 days prior to voting on such changes or amendments. Publication of changes or amendments on the society's website shall constitute fulfillment of this section.

## ARTICLE IX <br> PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE

Section 1 - All meetings of the society and committees shall be governed by Robert's Rules of Order, Revised.

> ARTICLE X DISSOLUTION

Section 1 - If and when the society should be dissolved and cease to function, all assets then in possession of the society shall be distributed for one or more tax exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the IRS code, or a corresponding section of any future Federal Tax code.

Section 2 - Upon the dissolution of the society, all collections, books, records, microfilm, etc., shall be given to the nearest Southeastern Oklahoma genealogical and or historical facility which will accept them. Funds shall first be used to benefit the dispersal of the collections, any remaining funds should be given to a Southeastern Oklahoma genealogical society in need. Any other assets, i.e., office equipment, microfilm readers, etc. not needed by the collection recipient should go to a local school, library, etc., who meet the IRS criteria.

## Last Will \& Testament of John Emanuel Oakes

## IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN:

I, John Emanuel Oakes of Ervin Okla., State of Oklahoma, being now of sound mind and memory, and knowing the uncertainty of human life, and desiring to make disposition of my property and affairs while in health and strength, do hereby make and publish, and do hereby declare the following to be my last Will and Testament, revoking and cancelling all other or former wills made by me at any time.

FIRST: I direct the payment of all my just debts and funeral expenses.
SECOND: All to my wife, Annie Oakes.
LASTLY: I hereby appoint and designate Thomas C. Oakes, Sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament.
IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I John E. Oakes have to this, my Last Will and Testament, hereunto set my hand, and subscribed my name, this 23 day of April, A. D., 1917.

John Emanuel Oakes.

That John Emanuel Oakes died on or about the 6th day of July, A. D. 1922, at Hugo, In Choctaw County, State of Oklahoma:
That the said John Emanuel Oakes, deceased, at the time of his death was a resident of the County of Choctaw, State of Oklahoma, and left property in the County of Choctaw, State of Oklahoma;

That the character of said property and the probable value thereof, and the probable revenue therefrom, are as follows, to-wit:

That the said John Emanuel Oakes, deceased left a will bearing the date of April 23, 1917, which your petitioner believes is, and therefore alleges to be, the last will and testament of the said John Emanuel Oakes, deceased, and which is herewith presented to the Court for probate, and is attached hereto, and made a part of this petition;

That your petitioner is the surviving wife of said John Emanuel Oakes, deceased, and is the person named in said will as the sole devisee and legatee.
That Thomas C. Oakes of Ervin, Oklahoma, is named in said will as the sole executor thereof; that your petitioner is informed and believes that the said Thomas C. Oakes has consented to act as such executor, and that he is a fit and suitable person to discharge the said trust.

That the petitioner, Annie Oakes, whose Post Office address is Ervin, Oklahoma, is the sole devisee and legatee under said will.
That the next of kin of said testator, whom your petitioner is advised and believes, and therefore alleges to be, the only heirs at law of said testator, and the names, ages and places of residence of said heirs, are as follows, to-wit:

That at the time said will was executed, to-wit: in the 23 rd day of April, A. D. 1917, the said testator was over the age of eighteen years, to-wit: 46 years, and was of sound and disposing mind and memory, and not acting under duress, manace, fraud or undue influence, and was in every respect competent to dispose of his estate by last will and testament;

That said Will is in writing, duly signed by said testator and duly declared and published as the last will and testament of said testator, and duly attested by subscribing witnesses.

WHERFORE, your petitioner prays that the said will be admitted to probate; that letters testamentary be issued to the said Thomas C. ## MOSHULATUBBE

1830-1834 During Removal
1834-1836 New District
Choctaw Nuggets by Pat Starbuck
This was copied from a headstone at Hall Cemetery near Cameron, Oklahoma. It was placed by the Oklahoma Historical Society in 1965.

Chief Moshulatubbee Amosholi-T-vbi "Warrior Who Perseveres" Born 1770
Chief Moshulatubbee of Northern district, Choctaw Nation in Mississippi, received his name as a young warrior. He was dignified in bearing, of fine physique, steady and thoughtful in disposition. As Chief he was noted for his orders banning liquor traffic and drinking in his county. He strongly favored education, and a mission school (ABCFM) was located at this prairie village near the Natchez Trace in 1824. Moshulatubbee was one of the three head chiefs who signed the early Choctaw treaties with the United States, including that at Dancing Rabbit Creek in 1830, which provided for the removal of the Choctaws from Mississippi. He had high hopes in coming west with his people in 1832, and made his new home in LeFlore County. He died at his home on August 30, 1838 from smallpox and was buried nearby, his grave covered in unmarked stones. The region from the Arkansas River to the Winding Stair Mountains was called Moshulatubbee District in law books of the Choctaw Nation, 1834 to 1907.

My mother was orphaned when a baby and we were never quite sure how much Indian she was but always thought she was one-half Choctaw and one-half Chickasaw. Benny Hunter, father of Judge Thomas W. Hunter, raised her and gave her a fine education. I was given the entire name of one of her first missionary teachers, Miss Susanne MacBeth.

There was a large family of us, so Father built us a little school house all our own in the yard and Mother taught us until I was nine when she died. I attended Oak Cliff College in Dallas and Paris Female College in Paris, Texas. I was attending that college in Paris when it burned. Then I began attending summer Normals in the Indian Territory and was licensed to teach school. I taught five years. I had taught my second term at Wheelock Academy when I was married to Dr. Ben L. Denison, in 1902. He was the physician for the Academy. I met him there.

When we teachers would leave the Academy for the summer, we would try to find summer homes for nearly all of the orphans there. If we could not find homes for them we would take them to our own homes for the summer and one summer I left one at my father's home and took two to Jones Academy with me. That was where a summer Normal was being held. Board, room and tuition for a four weeks term was only $\$ 12.00$ so it was not so expensive to take a little girl along and it made her happy. We never liked to leave the children at Wheelock for the summer, it was so lonely for them with all the teachers gone.

I am the mother of 6 children, four of whom are living. Harry L. Denison would be 32 years old if living. He was drowned two years ago. Roy died when he was a baby Hilliard is a Civil Engineer in New Mexico. My daughter, Mrs. Juanita Jenkins, lives in Ohio. Wyota Sue, another daughter, is now visiting in New Mexico. My baby eighteen years old is attending high school at Bozier City, Louisiana.

My husband, Dr. Ben L. Denison died a couple of years ago and is buried in the Denison cemetery which was donated to the city of Idabel by his brother, John Denison.

My father was Charles D. Oakes, the oldest of the children of Thomas Oakes and Harriet Everidge Oakes. There was a large family of my mother's children, then she died when I was nine and Father remarried and raised another family. He died about 1914 and was buried in the family graveyard at the old home place at Goodwater.

Another thing I had almost forgotten was that my mother taught Sunday School in our little private school house just as regularly as Sunday came around.

## Deceased Pioneer Was Firm Believer in Law and Order

Charles D. Oakes, pioneer resident of Choctaw county who died January 14 at his home near Ervin, southeast of here, at the age of 83 , was firm believer in law and order, according to those who were intimately acquainted with him. While this section was still almost a wilderness, he made many trips on horse back, with his old-time cross back saddle pockets, to attend federal court at Fort Smith.
"He possessed many, if not all, of the qualities that make a good man," it was declared. "He had rather give than receive, never turned away the hungry, was kind hearted and always ready to lend a helping hand. He believed in God, professed his belief and hope of an Eternal Home."

Mr. Oakes passed away peacefully, without a struggle. Funeral services were conducted by the Reverend Mr. Hawley, Presbyterian minister, at the family home Thursday evening at 2 o'clock.

Charles D. Oakes was born April 15, 1841. He served four years in the Confederate army during the Civil war.
