ORDER OF COURT.

On this day came on to be heard the petition of James LeFlore for an order approving a deed of conveyance made by him to S. M. Briscoe conveying certain lands allotted to Miky LeFlore, described as follows, to-wit:

The SW/2 and the SE/4 of NW/4 of Sec. 15 and the SE/4 of the NW/4 of Sec. 29, all in Twp. No 2 North, and Range 6 West, the same being the allotment of the said Miky LeFlore as a member of the Choctaw tribe of Indians.

And the Court finds that the said Miky LeFlore died intestate in that portion of the then Indian Territory now embraced within the boundaries of Choctaw County on the 3rd day of October, 1902 and left surviving her as her only child and only heir, the petitioner, James LeFlore, a full blood newborn of the Choctaw Tribe of Indians, and that the said James LeFlore has this day executed a deed to the said lands to S. M. Briscoe for the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars which has been paid, and the said James LeFlore, having appeared before me in person and being fully advised in the premises,

It is considered, ordered and adjudged by the court that said deed be, and the same is in all things confirmed and approved.
