JUDGMENT AND ORDER OF APPROVAL.

Now on this 14th day of August, 1908, coming on to be heard the application of Ed Roebuck and Zack Roebuck as  $\frac{3}{4}$  blood heirs of Malina Roebuck, deceased, approved by this Court, and the Court being fully advised as to the law and the facts, and it appearing to the Court that the said Malina Roebuck was enrolled as a full-blood member of the Choctaw Tribe of Indians, and as such there was selected and allotted in her name the following described lands, to-wit:

The  $\frac{W}{2}$  of the  $\frac{NW}{4}$  and the  $\frac{NE}{4}$  of the  $\frac{NW}{4}$  and the  $\frac{N}{2}$  of the  $\frac{SE}{4}$  of the  $\frac{NW}{4}$  of Section 24, Twp. 6 South, and Range 16 East, and the South  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $\frac{SE}{4}$  of the  $\frac{NW}{4}$  and the  $\frac{W}{2}$  of the  $\frac{NE}{4}$  and the  $\frac{S}{2}$  of the  $\frac{NE}{4}$  of the  $\frac{NE}{4}$  and the  $\frac{N}{2}$  of the  $\frac{SE}{4}$  of the  $\frac{NE}{4}$  and the  $\frac{SW}{4}$  of the  $\frac{SE}{4}$  of  $\frac{NE}{4}$  of Section 24, Twp. 6 South Range 16 East.

And it appearing to the Court that the said Malina Roebuck, deceased, was at the time of her death a resident of what is now Choctaw County, Oklahoma, and departed this life on or about the 13th day of May, 1907, intestate, leaving as her heirs at law the petitioners herein, Edward Roebuck, Rudy Ervin, David B. Roebuck, Willie Roebuck, her children, and Zack Roebuck, James Bryant, Laura Bryant and Ora Bryant, grandchildren, and it appearing to the Court that the aforesaid Ed Roebuck and Zack Roebuck have sold their interest in the lands above described to Thomas Ingram of Hugo, Oklahoma, for a consideration of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars, for said Edward Roebuck's interest which is a  $\frac{1}{5}$  interest, and for the consideration of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for said Zack' Roebuck's interest which is a  $\frac{1}{20}$  interest, and it appearing to the Court that the same is a fair and adequate consideration for the same and has been duly received by the aforesaid Edward Roebuck and Zack Roebuck;

Now therefore, it is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the conveyance and warranty deed executed and delivered to the aforesaid Thomas Ingram, on the 14th day of August, 1908, by the said heirs, be and the same is hereby in all things approved.
