Larecy and it being made to appear to the satisfaction of the Court that one George Sanders, late a citizen of what is now Choctaw County, Oklahoma, died therein seized and possessed of the said land, that the said George Sanders was a full-blood Choctaw Indian, and that the said lands constituted part of his allotment, and that the said Robert Sanders and his wife Susan Sanders are the father and mother respectively of the said George Sanders, and it further appearing that the said Robert Sanders and Susan Sanders executed their certain deed to John F. Larecy on the 10th day of August, 1908, conveying to him the NE/4 of the SW/4 and the S/2 of the NW/4 of the SW/4 and the N/2 of the S/2 of the SW/4 all in Section 20, and the SE/4 of the SW/4 of the NW/4 of Section 29, and the S/2 of the NW/4 and the N/2 of the NW/4 of the SW/4 of Section 20, Twp. 4 South, Range 6 West, at and for the sum and price of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, and it further appearing that said consideration has been fully paid, is fair and reasonable and satisfactory to the grantors; It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said deed of conveyance to John F. Larecy be and the same is hereby approved and in all things confirmed, this 15th day of August, 1908.
