IN THE MATTER OF THE ESTATE OF WINNIE BATTIEST, DECEASED.

Anthony Bohanan having this day filed in this court his petition, duly verified by oath, wherein he prays for the approval and confirmation of a certain sale and conveyance made by him of his interest in the real estate hereinafter described to Solomon Battiest and Sallie Battiest; and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that Winnie Battiest departed this life in what is now Choctaw County, Oklahoma, on the 17th day of December, 1903, seized and possessed of the following described real estate situated in said Choctaw County, state of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The SE/4 and the W/2 of the NE/4 and the W/2 of the E/2 of the NE/4 of Section 32, Twp. 6 South, Range 17 East:

That the said Winnie Battiest was a full-blood Choctaw Indian, and said lands constituted her allotment of homestead and surplus, and that said Anthony Bohanan is likewise a full-blood Choctaw Indian, and the Court further finds that the said Anthony Bohanan was a brother and heir at law of the said Winnie Battiest and as such is entitled to an undivided one third interest in the lands above described; that the said Anthony Bohanan has this day conveyed his said undivided one-third interest to Solomon Battiest and Sallie Battiest at and for the sum and price of Five Hundred Dollars; that said consideration has been fully paid, and is fair and reasonable and satisfactory to the grantor.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said sale and conveyance by the said Anthony Bohanan to the said Solomon Battiest and Sallie Battiest be and the same hereby is approved and in all things confirmed: This 19th day of August, 1908.
