ORDER.

Now on this 5th day of September, 1908, this cause coming on regularly to be heard upon the conveyance made by petitioners, Lane Wilson and Bicy Wilson, full-blood Choctaws, to the allotment of Peter Wilson, deceased, and the Court after hearing all the evidence adduced in the case doth find; That this Court has jurisdiction of the estate of Peter Wilson, Deceased; that Lane Wilson and Bicy Wilson are the heirs; that the said Peter Wilson died seized of the lands set out and described in the petition filed herein; that on the 10th day of August, 1908, the said Lane Wilson and Bicy Wilson made and executed a warranty deed to M. C. Mhoon and V. Bronaugh for the sum of One Thousand and Fifty (\$1050.00) Dollars, in which they conveyed the allotment of Peter Wilson, described in the petition filed herein and that the said conveyance is regular, proper and should be approved.
