The petition of Charlie Thomas and Mary Thomas coming on this day to be heard, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that petitioners are the father and mother respectively of Nicholas Thomas, deceased, who departed this life intestate on the 11th day of November, 1904, without lineal heirs; and it further appearing to the Court that the said Nicholas Thomas was a full blood Choctaw Indian and that he died seized and possessed of the real estate hereinafter described, and that upon his death the said Charlie Thomas became seized of a life estate in said land, and that the said Mary Thomas would be entitled to a life estate in the same after the death of the said Charlie Thomas; and it further appearing that the said Charlie Thomas and Mary Thomas have sold and conveyed all of their right, title and interest in the same to W. T. Roberts, at and for the sum of \$250.00, and that the said consideration has been fully paid and is satisfactory to the grantors;

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said deed, conveying the respective life estates of said petitioners in and to the following described real estate, situated in the County of Choctaw, State of Oklahoma, to wit:

E/2 of SE/4 of SE/4 of Sec. 10, and W/2 of SW/4 of Sec. 11, and NE/4 of NE/4 and N/2 of SE/4 of NE/4 of Sec. 15, all in Twp. 1, South, Range 6 West; and W/2 of NE/4 of Sec. 10, Twp. 6 South, Range 18 East, to said W. T. Roberts, be and the said is hereby approved, and in all things confirmed.
