In the Probate Court within and for Choctaw County, Oklahoma:

JUDGMENT AND ORDER OF A PPROVAL.

Now on this day coming on to be hear the petition of John Ahekatubby and others to have a deed made by the full blood heirs to inherited lands approved by the Court, and the Court being fully informed as to the law and the facts, and it appearing to the Court that the aforesaid John Ahekatubby and Emma Ahekatubby, and Sallt Tom, and Francis Pishmatubby, and Emily Billy, and Rhoda Mishaia, and William Mishaia, and Jim Mishaia, and Bich Bohanan, are full blood members of the Choctaw Tribe of Indians, and are the heirs at law of John Ahekatubby Jr., deceased, and it appearing to the Court, that the said John Ahekatubby Jr., was at the time of his death a resident of Choctaw County, Oklahoma, and that he was the owner of the following described lands, towit:

The SE/4 of the NE/4 of the SW/4 and the SE/4 of the SW/4 of Sec. 27, and the NE/4 of the NW/4, and the N/2 of the SE/4 of the NW/4, and the SE/4 of the SE/4 of the NW/4 of Sec. 34, all in Twp. 5, North, Range 7 West.

And it appearing to the Court that the said John Ahekatubby Jr., departed this life intestate on the 19th day of August, 1907, and it appearing to the pearing to the Court that the deed this day made, executed and deliveredn unto B. A. Nelson, in consideration of the sum of \$800.00, is fairly made and it appearing to the Court that the said sum of \$800.00 is a fair adequate and sufficient consideration for such transfer, and it further appearing to the Court that the petitioners herein have received from the said B. A. Nelson the said sum of \$800.00.

Now therefore it is ordered, adjudged and decreed that the deed of conveyance this day made by the petitioners herein to the said B. A. Nelson be, and it is hereby in all things approved.
