IN THE MATTER OF the estate of Joanna Frazier, Deceased.

Harris Frazier having presented his petition, duly verified by oath, praying the approval of a certain deed of conveyance made and executed by said Petitioner to A. J. Waldock. And said Petition coming on this day to be heard, and it having been made to appear to the satisfaction of the Court that Joanna Frazier departed this life intestate on the 22nd day of March, 1904, seized and possessed of the lands hereinafter described; that the said Joanna Frazier was, at the time of her death, a resident citizen of what is now Choctaw County, Oklahoma, and was a full blood Choctaw Indian; and that said real estate consisted her allotment as such Choctaw Indian; that Harris Frazier was the husband of the said Joanna Frazier, and that during the said marriage they had issue born alive, and that said Harris Frazier is entitled to an estate of curtesy in said real estate; that said Harris Frazier has sole and conveyed unto A. J. Waldock his life estate in and to the following real estate, belonging to the estate of said Joanna Frazier, Deceased, to-wit: SW/4 of NW/4 and SW/4 of NW/4 of NW/4 of Sec. 32; and the SE/4 of Sec. 31, all in Twp. 9, North, Range 6 West, in Grady County, Oklahoma, at and for the sum of \$700, and has executed deed of conveyance accordingly; that the consideration is payable \$100 cash, and the balance of \$600 one year from the date of said deed, secured by a vendor's lien on said real estate; that said consideration is fair and reasonable and is satisfactory to the grantor.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said deed of conveyance from the said Harris Frazier to A. J. Waldock on date Nov. 21st, 1908, be and the same hereby is approved and in all things confirmed. This 25th day of Nov., 1908.
