On this the 24th day of December, 1908, came on to be heard the petition of Billie Jackson for the approval of sale and deed given by him to C. A. Humphry for the following tract of land, to-wit:

The West half of the northwest quarter and the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section twelve (12), Township five (5) South, Range sixteen (16) East

And it appearing to the Court that the land described is a part of the allotment of Elder Jackson deceased, who died prior to statehood, leaving him surviving him Billie Jackson and Ludie Lewis children and only heirs and next of kin to said Elder Jackson, deceased, the mother of said Billie Jackson and Ludie Lewis being deceased.

That said Elder Jackson died in what is now Choctaw County Oklahoma, and letters of administration has been granted and the Court having jurisdiction of the said estate of the said Elder Jackson, deceased, and it further appearing to the court that the consideration has been paid and that Billie Jackson well known to the Court to be competent to transact his business the said prayer of his petition is hereby granted and the deed so made by him to the said C. A. Humphry is in all things approved.

This order having been made by the Court but not entered of record it is ordered that the same be entered of record now for then.
