

Well Known Choctaw Arrested Charged With The Murder of Cross

The Choctaw County Democrat Thursday October 19, 1911 - transcribed by Ron Henson

Sim Harrison, an Indian who lives about five miles north east of town was arrested Tuesday charged with the murder of Wm Cross. This is the third arrest made in this case. Thomas Henson and Charlie Ross are now in jail.

Uncle Sim gave bond and was released, the bond being signed by some of the best men in this county. No one in this section believes that he is in any way connected with the murder, and his many friends believe he will have no trouble in proving his innocence.

Street Rumors this morning say that Charlie Ross had admitted he killed Cross himself and that Uncle Sim had nothing to do with it.
