- A beautiful city of eight thousand people, and is the county seat of Choctaw County; a rapidly growing proposition.
- Hugo is the grand central passenger traffic point from Little Rock on the east to Oklahoma City on the northwest, and from the Great Lakes to the north, and south to the Gulf States.
- Hugo has a tremendous freight traffic from all points of the compass, both being assembled here and distributed to all points in Southeastern Oklahoma, including distribution across Red River.
- Hugo is famous for its great number of modern cottages and palatial homes, with perfect civic conditions surrounding them, and beautiful shade trees galore.
- Hugo has five and two-tenth miles of paved streets, and twenty-three miles of concrete walks; three modern ward school buildings.
- Hugo has a perfect water system, taking pure free-stone water from the beautiful Kiamichi River, sufficient to support a city of half million people.
- Hugo is the logical trade center of Pushmataha, Choctaw, McCurtain Counties, from which it draws a very large trade annually, having a local trade of twenty-five miles in each direction.
- Hugo is the concentrating point for all farm products compressing for the foreign trade near one hundred thousand bales of cotton annually, also a large stock shipping point, and other farm products.
- Hugo has not only at home but abroad, the name of being a live city, all along the constructive lines, which is perfectly true. Perfect city building is one of its first considerations, conforming to modern city plans, as practiced in all modern cities.
- Hugo some two years ago realized the best investment possible to make, that brings the dividends of the highest, was the building of good roads, and as a result good roads radiate in every direction from the city into the rural districts. This condition was brought about through the untiring efforts of the Hugo Chamber of Commerce.
- Motto, Hugo Chamber of Commerce:

 - Every year a better year.
