Hullinger Released

William Hullinger, on trial with Will Willburn for the killing of John Young, near Spencerville, last fall, was released by the same jury that convicted Willburn. The evidence showed that the only reason of Hullinger being mixed up in the affair was that he was not on good terms with the deceased.
