Smallpox

The small pox situation is very much improved here and in fact all over the county, except at Soper, where five new cases were reported this week, but they were expected and are well taken care of. The two cases at this place are about well. The negro man who has waited on his wife during her illness has not taken them yet. Taking it all together the outlook is as good or better, than could be expected.
